

Central Texas Wolf Pack – Interested Players Information Letter

- You must be a **fulltime** public safety employee to be eligible to play with the Wolf Pack football team:
 1. Law Enforcement Officer,
 2. Firefighters,
 3. Corrections Officer, or
 4. Emergency Medical Technician
- **Player Dues:**
 - All players must have their team dues (\$350) paid prior to the January 9th practice. This is our first team practice in 2010 and all dues must be paid prior to participation on the field. A player with unpaid dues may attend practice and observe, but may not participate until dues are paid in full.
- **Player Responsibilities:** The team will provide you with two practice jerseys and our primary game jersey (BLACK). Players will need to purchase the following:
 - Equipment – Players are responsible for their own equipment:
 - Helmets must be Notre Dame gold with a black facemask.
 - Shoulder pads (team has some shoulder pads, but no promise you can be outfitted with our stock)
 - Lower-body pads
 - AWAY Game Jersey:
 - Solid White with black letters and numbers (block type)
 - 10" numbers on the front & 12" numbers on the back
 - WOLF PACK in 2 ½" letters above the front number
 - Players may put their last name on the back (2" letters)
 - Game Attire:
 - Solid black game pants
 - Solid black socks
 - Practice Attire:
 - Provided by the team (i.e. pants and jersey)
- **Practice & Game Commitments:**
 - Each player is expected to make every effort to attend every practice. It is not likely that each player will make every practice, therefore there is a program designed to ensure we know who will be present.
 - 1 week prior to each practice a Practice Notification E-Mail will be sent to each player and each player must reply with either **Confirmed** or **Declined**, no excuses please, just one of those words is sufficient and all

that is expected. 24 hours prior to the scheduled practice players must check their E-Mail to ensure practice has not been canceled.

- **Out-Of-State Travel Game:**

- The Wolf Pack will travel to Los Angeles for a game to be played against the LAPD Centurions on March 20th. The team will arrive on Thursday, March 18th and return on Sunday, March 21st.
- Each player will be responsible for their own travel arrangements. You should try and get a flight that puts you at the LAX airport NLT 4:00pm. As we will have the LAPD Centurions providing transportation. You can schedule your flight to leave anytime on March 21st. If your travel time is restricted and you must make arrangements outside of these guidelines, you may need to get yourself to the team hotel (TBA at a later time). NOTE: YOU MUST SEND RUTH AND I YOUR FLIGHT INFORMATION IMMEDIATELY UPON MAKING YOUR ARRANGEMENTS!
- Players will be expected to maintain the following team itinerary (will be provided at check-in):
 - Thursday will be a free day/night for those who arrive on this day. Ensure you check in with Team Manager/Team Mom ("Baby Ruth" Bullock) upon arrival at the hotel @ 512-673-0307.
 - Friday – Team Meeting/Walk-Through
 - 2:00pm – Hotel conference room
 - Saturday – Game Day
 - 11:30am – In hotel lobby awaiting transport to stadium (wearing team polo (\$25))
 - 12:00pm – Departure for the stadium
 - Upon game ending all players will be expected to attend the Post-Game Party hosted by the host team. After making your appearance at the party all players are on their own.
- For those getting Rental Cars, you may be asked to help shuttle players arriving/departing at the odd times from the rest of the group.

- **In-State-Travel Games**

- When we travel to our in-state games, we will leave the morning of the game and meet at a pre-determined departure point. Players may choose to car-pool. Some may choose to leave earlier; it will be their responsibility to ensure they have the game location and check-in time at the host stadium. Immediately after the game we will return back to Austin.
- If a player receives sponsorship that covers their airfare, that sponsorship shall be turned over to Wolf Pack staff and the player will be given a check for the cost of their airfare.

- For the out-of-state travel game, the travel itinerary, complete with scheduled meetings and meals, will be provided 60 days prior to travel.
- If a new player joins the Wolf Pack late, any intentions to travel to the out-of-state game must be made immediately so the team knows who will be traveling with the team.
